



ATTACHING SAFETY FLAGS

Husky Bicycles offers two types of safety flags, a 1-piece flag and a 2-piece flag. The process of attaching to your bicycle or your tricycle is substantially the same for 1-piece or 2-piece flags.

TOOLS NEEDED:

A 15mm open, box, or socket wrench or a crescent wrench

1. Safety flags come with a steel bracket to hold the flag pole. This bracket is designed to attach to the left-hand side of a bicycle's rear wheel axle or to a tricycle's coaster brake hub axle.
2. Loosen the axle nut by about 1mm and place the bracket over the axle. Tighten the nut, making sure that the bracket is held vertical to the ground. (picture 1)
3. Insert the end of flag pole into the steel bracket (picture 2).
4. Rotate the flag to the desired position.
5. For 2-piece flags, first insert the lower piece into the bracket, then connect the upper piece.
